THE LUNG TODAY

A Pink Puffer and a Blue Bloater are not respectively a tropical fish or a hat for the Royal Regatta at Henley, but rather, patients with **common treatable respiratory diseases**. Could you recognize them? Similarly, when is a **wheeze** not a **wheeze**? Is **Danang Lung** an oriental rarity confined to veterans? Who may give you an **allergic salute** or **purse** his lips at you? Did William Shakespeare describe the Pickwickian syndrome? What pulmonary hazard do pigeon breeders have? Are you comfortable when other physicians CPAP or PEEP at you? TLC is not tender loving care.

Patterns of pulmonary disease have euded in recent years and concepts of treatment are continually being honed. The Lung Today is designed to bring the general family physician up to date. The program clearly delineates important basic concepts of pulmonary disease and describes recent trends in diagnosis and treatment. Specifically, at the conclusion of the program participants should be able to:

- Describe normal values for blood gases; how to draw blood for blood gas analysis; those conditions where blood gas analysis is especially important in management.
- Enumerate the important pulmonary scanning techniques, and their diagnostic usefulness
- Rationally decide when to recommend endoscopy for patients with respiratory symptoms and assess its capabilities
- Effectively diagnose and treat acute respiratory emergencies
- Select appropriate treatment for patients with chronic respiratory failure
- Apply recent research findings in the management of childhood and adult bronchial asthma
- Recognize the presence and severity of pulmonary complications to dermatological disease

- Describe current concepts of pulmonary oncologic treatment
- Enumerate the various granulomatous pulmonary disorders endemic to Southern California, especially Valley Fever and Tuberculosis, and describe current therapy
- Evaluate clinically important noncardiorespiratory causes of chest pain
- Describe specific patterns of pulmonary damage and symptoms resulting from industrial or atmospheric pollution or drug exposure

Open to graduates of approved medical schools.
