In the city of Lima, capital of Perú, took place an important activity related to the ICS and the thoughtful work of the World Health Organization - Pan American Health Organization (WHO-PAHO) Regional Office. In this event, participation by very important institutions of Perú occurred, including the Association of Peruvian Schools of Medicine (ASPEFAM), President is Prof. Manuel Huamán Guerrero, and the PAHO and the Peru Ministry of Public Health.

The Workshop title follows: WHO-PAHO: Expectations and Strategies in Perú and the World.

In the round table discussion, moderated by Prof. Manuel Huamán Guerrero, with the participation of Mr. Max Downham, Dr. Fidel Ruiz Healy, Dr. Carlos Arósquipa Rodríguez, and Dr. Segundo Cruz Bejarano were discussed important topics, with the presence of University representatives, including Deans of the 25 Schools of Medicine of Perú, and representatives of other national and public health organizations.

The resulting conclusions from this highly important, first-time meeting, are important for medical education and for national and International health. I will share these conclusions with the different institutions, which will be a big help and be taken as elements of great stimulation in the growth of public health in Perú and the World, especially in underdeveloped areas.

ICS AFRICAN FEDERATON BY PROFESSOR NDUBUISI EKE, AFRICAN FEDERATION SECRETARY

Discussions with a few Ghanaian surgeons had been going on for about two years. Max Downham, the ICS Executive Director and I, Prof Ndubuisi Eke, the Secretary, African Federation of the ICS planned to meet in Ghana at the West African College of Surgeons (WACS) Annual Conference in Kumasi, Ghana from February 24, 2014 to March 1. Kumasi, like the rest of Ghana, had a pleasant weather and was peaceful.

At the opening ceremony of the Conference, the International College of Surgeons, represented by Max Downham and myself, was recognized among a few other surgical Colleges. Later during the Conference, we made a joint presentation highlighting the International College, its vision and mission. The surgeons from Ghana were given ICS application forms. An opportunity to inaugurate the Ghana Section of ICS was sought from the Chairman of the Organizing Committee of WACS. Most of the Ghanaian surgeons live and work in and around Accra, the capital of Ghana. The opportunity we sought was not given. It was decided that one of the

Ghanaian surgeons, Dr Charles Dally, who is already a Fellow of ICS should liaise with his colleagues to inaugurate the Ghana Section. Efforts are on to initiate more sections in the West African subregion. The small number of surgeons in the countries is a challenge. We hope this will be surmounted soon. Nigerian National Section is getting stronger and spur on the rest. Efforts to enlist contact surgeons in East and South Africa as well as Egypt need to be intensified.

Other developments at that Conference included discussion with the President of the WACS, Prof Koffi H. Yagni-Angate, to develop a memorandum of understanding between WACS and ICS. This is more pertinent considering that the two Colleges share some visions and missions such as development and training of surgeons as well as service to humanity through surgery outreach programs. Prof Yagni-Angate who comes from Ivory Coast agreed to start the Ivory Coast (Cote d'Ivoire) National Section. He was given a copy of the ICS constitution as a guide. The WACS is scheduled to have the 2015 Annual Conference in Yamoussoukro (Abidjan), capital of Cote d'Ivoire. By then, the Cote d'Ivoire National Section would have been inaugurated.

In June 11-14, the Nigerian National Section held her Annual Scientific and General Meeting in Asaba, the Capital of Delta State of Nigeria. The highest number of new Fellows, 69, was inducted at that Conference. It is the wish and prayer that the new Fellows will develop abiding interest in the activities of the College in Nigeria and worldwide. The 2015 version will be held in Port Harcourt, Rivers State.
